COMPUTER MAINTENANCE HARDWARE

Computer Maintenance Hardware – “To prolong the life of your PC, you must inspect and clean it regularly. Inspecting your PC alerts you to any dangerous or damaging conditions. Cleaning areas include: PC and monitor case, the monitor screen, the keyboard and any printer, switch, scanner, mouse and other devices connected to the PC.” There are liquid cleaning compounds (denatured alcohol), cleaning tools (non-static brush, canned air, lint-free cloth) and small hand-held vacuum. Inspect cables. Now the inside ... clean the contacts, connectors, motherboard and components. Internal cleaning requires removing of the desk top computer cover (stand alone computer require different procedures). Always unplug your computer before “inside” maintenance. Cooling fans should be cleaned of dust. Cooling fans are critical to maintain continuous instrument operations. Air flow is critical.
