**Speaker:** Kara Escajeda, Nolanville City Manager

**Topic:** Update on the city of Nolanville – they have had increased growth with a recent annexation, 14% increase in sales tax revenue, 25% increase for roads and sidewalks by the school. With interest rates low they have been able to refinance old debt at 2% and acquire a \$500,000 note for 5 years to fix drainage issues. Using grant money makes progress slow but it is moving along with improvements to the city being completed. They have hired a landscape architect for beautification of Main Street. New businesses are opening up in an existing building such as a bicycle repair shop and a veterinarian. Rockwall insulation factory has reopened and Boat World is planning to relocate to Nolanville. The City Park has a grant for a splash pad and playground. They received a 2<sup>nd</sup> place award for small city government. She plans to be 1<sup>st</sup> place this year! Lions Club has started work on an adopt a tree project. A fundraiser spaghetti dinner is coming up.

**FYI: Motivation Education**

There are three types of motivation according to a Harvard study by David McClelland ... Achievement (need to establish and meet goals; enjoy success), Power (need to have a say in what happens; enjoy influencing others) and Affiliation (need to feel part of a group; enjoy harmony). Examples are: Achievement – willing to take calculated risks but find failure difficult to accept; Power – think about having control of situations and channeling people toward goals, finding ways to use influence to persuade others and obtain status and authority; Affiliation – are first to help people in trouble and like to establish close relationships with fellow volunteers.
