**FYI: Solar Eclipse Education**

**ED SOLAR ECLIPSE**

“Do Solar Eclipse Affect the Weather?” - “Solar eclipse not only mimic nighttime by turning the sky dark, they also bring evening’s cooler air temperature. If you are standing outdoors on August 21, you’ll feel these things first hand. The temperature will dip gradually at first and then fall steadily as ‘totality’ occurs. After totality ends, air temperatures will slowly warm again. According to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), air temperatures cool by about 10-15 degrees Fahrenheit (depending on your location). There are solar winds, however the eclipse tends to slow these winds. Viewing statistics for Austin (Harker Heights will be similar) are: Start: 11:41 AM, Greatest viewing (65.1%) and End 2:39 PM. Don’t look at sun without proper eye protection”.
