### HEALTH RECORDS

“Most people have heard about ‘HIPPA’ ... the federal law that governs your medical records. Created in 1996, the law gives you, the patient, many controls over who can see or get your medical records. There are many instances, where HIPPA is violated. To make sure that your medical information remains private ... 1. Don't give “blanket” permission; 2. Follow the “records trail” and 3. Put it in writing if there is a problem”.
