FYI: Identity Theft Education

IDENTITY THEFT. "ID" occurs when someone uses your personally identifying information without your permission, to commit fraud or other crimes". Schemes to commit identity theft or fraud may involve violations of: Credit Card, Computer, Mail, Financial Institution or Social Security Fraud. Thieves secured personal information by "pretexting", i.e. stealing, changing, acquiring, posing as telemarketers, searching home, phishing, etc. Never use: mother's maiden, middle, children or pet's names. Protect your "snail" mail, secure your internet connections and be leery of "free" offers. Do not: "pay any bill from fraudulent activities, cover check you didn't write, file for bankruptcy or allow yourself to be coerced".
