## FYI: Transfer of Power Education

### PRESIDENTIAL TRANSITION OR PRESIDENTIAL INTERREGNUM.

“The transition is the period of time between the end of the president election and the inauguration of a new President. During this time, the incoming President usually designates new government personnel, including selecting new Cabinet positions and government department or agency heads. The outgoing “lame duck” President has lost many of the intangible benefits of a Presidency but the incoming President-elect is not yet legally empowered to affect policy. During this period (+/- 75 days), agencies consolidate and prepare for the transfer of both Federal and Presidential records according to the XX Amendment to the Constitution, Public Law and the National Archives and Records Administration.
