**FYI: Government Education

Presidential Power – Article II of the Constitution states the powers of the President. Laws, mandates and policies implement these powers and in turn, can provide or deny other applicable powers. 1. Commander-in-Chief; 2. Grant reprieves and pardons except in the case of impeachment; 3. Together with Congress, declare war; 4. Inform Congress via State of the Union address; 5. Make treaties with advice and consent of Congress; 6. May recommend legislature; 7. See that laws are executed. 8. Manage within the 1976 National Emergencies Act; 9. Has the power to prevent any bill from becoming law unless Congress passes it over his veto; 10. Appoint Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls, Judges of the Supreme Court, and others official of the United States; 11. Fill vacancies during recess of the Senate; 12. On extraordinary occasions, convene both Houses, or either of them and adjourn the same; 13. Commission all Officers of the United States.
