Topic: Heroes on Water Ft Hood Chapter – June 24 at Dana Peak Park, on Stillhouse Lake from 7:30 am – 2:30 pm. The program helps our nation’s warriors and veterans from all branches of military service unwind and using therapeutic qualities of fishing from kayaks. Founded in 2007 allows the participants a chance to decompress from stresses associated with combat and the physical rigors of rehabilitation. Participants receive basic kayak and paddling instruction, angling clinics for all skill sets from beginner to the most experienced. The program is unique in that it is a long-term activity, not a one time event. We believe that the effectiveness of the program is a direct result of engaging the wounded military personnel for the long term. Once they acquire enough kayaks and equipment from fundraising and partnerships the program won’t need much funding. Local events happen at least once a quarter on Stillhouse and Belton Lakes. D-DAY

The [Western Allies](#) of [World War II](#) launched the largest [amphibious invasion](#) in history when they assaulted [Normandy](#), located on the northern coast of France, on 6 June 1944. The invaders were able to establish a [beachhead](#) as part of [Operation Overlord](#) after a [successful "D-Day,"](#) the first day of the invasion.

Allied land forces came from the [United States](#), [Britain](#), [Canada](#), and [Free French forces](#). In the weeks following the invasion, [Polish forces](#) and contingents from Belgium, Czechoslovakia, Greece and the Netherlands participated in the ground campaign; most also provided air and naval support alongside elements of the [Royal Australian Air Force](#), the [Royal New Zealand Air Force](#), and the [Royal Norwegian Navy](#).

The Normandy invasion began with overnight [parachute](#) and [glider](#) landings, massive [air attacks](#) and [naval bombardments](#). In the early morning, [amphibious landings](#) on five beaches codenamed [Sword](#), [Juno](#), [Gold](#), [Omaha](#) and [Utah](#), The United States landing on beaches Omaha and Utah, Great Britain landing on beaches Gold and Sword and Canada landing on Juno. The invasion began and during the evening the remaining elements of the airborne divisions landed. Land forces used on D-Day sailed from bases along the south coast of England, the most important of these being [Portsmouth](#).
