FYI: Community Taxes Education

Taxes are a fact of life. Taxes are designed to help support agencies with funds for operations. The tax rate is significant and determines the amount of your property taxes. Property taxes are leveled by locally elected officials. The Bell County Appraisal District only determines the value of your property. The 2017 Appraised Tax Value for Bell County (in dollars and cents) for each \$1,000 of the assessed property value are: a. Bell County – \$0.4212; b. Central Texas College - \$0.1366; c. Bell County Road - \$0.0299; d. Killeen ISD - \$1.126; e. City of Harker Heights - \$0.677 (tax rate in other communities differs from that of Harker Heights); f. Clearwater U.W.C.D. (Underground Water Control District) - \$0.003920.

Exemptions are granted based on several factors, i.e. disability, age and specified exemptions.
