## Harker Heights Kiwanis Club Meeting 01-24-17

**Speaker:** Maria Diaz

**Topic:** DaZona Life & Learning Center is a private non-profit Day Hab-facility created in 2013 to assist adults with special needs, to include spectrums of autism, cerebral palsy, individual developmental disorders, Down syndrome and more. They have about 30 clients now. Students must be over 18, can go to the bathroom themselves, non – aggressive behavior and non-sexual behavior in public. Each client receives an individual assessment. Their goal is to continue towards the individual care plans established by parents, teachers, caseworkers etc. The day begins with a PE class to get their bodies moving. 10 am begins the academic classes according to each client's level, then lunch. In the afternoon many will be learning life skills such as cleaning up the lunch room, how to wash and fold clothes, make a bed and easy cooking skills. Some students will learn computer skills and train for employment. A first dance is being planned for the center. They had a very successful cookout with many community members attending and plan to have one annually. Field trips to Peaceable Kingdom, the library, HEB and the Pumpkin Patch have been very successful and enjoyed by the students. Student fee is \$25 a day for those on private pay, others, tuition may come from state programs they are in or donations. For more information call : 254-699-2186 or
