Topic: Harker Heights Fire Dept update: The latest update on the remodel of the Fire Station # 2 – Hill & Wilkinson has been hired to do the job. They did the central fire station and pet adoption center remodel and have submitted the design for station #2 and doing the final preparations to begin the 2350 sq. ft addition. If they don't run into and big issues the planned completion should be the 3rd quarter of next year. The Wellness Center at the main station has been completed and in use. Two new programs for personnel and leadership have begun. A community wildfire protection program has been implemented with Texas A & M and the forest service. They create a buffer zone between homes and Dana Peak Park area growth to keep the homes safe if fire should break out. The fire dept. plans to get a new ladder truck in 2021 and a new ambulance is on order. October is Fire Prevention Month. They hold a poster contest for grades 4-6. HHES has always had grand winners. The dept plans to continue Thanksgiving baskets, Santa Pal and have Santa visit the neighborhoods on Christmas Eve.
