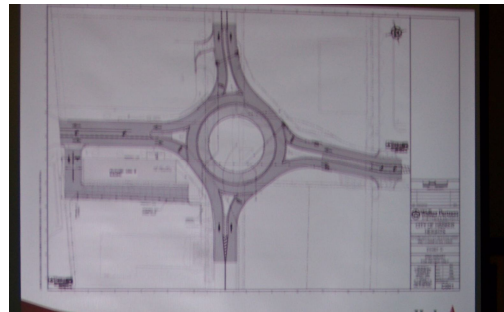


Harker Heights Kiwanis Club Meeting 03-05-19

Topic: Capital improvements - Harker Heights is a work in progress! The number one talked about projects are the “Roundabout” on Heights & Commercial Drives and the FM 2410 widening to Highland Oaks. Other big projects are 190 bridge turnaround and I-14 widening from Seton to Indian Trl. Other projects either in progress or approved to begin soon are: FM 3481 left turn lane project, signal at Vineyard Trl, FM 3481 water line extension, Warrior Path widening for the new school being built, Verna Lee sidewalks, drainage (4 phases) groundwater storage tanks and pump station painting, waste water interceptor project and FM 2410 trunk sewer phase 1. 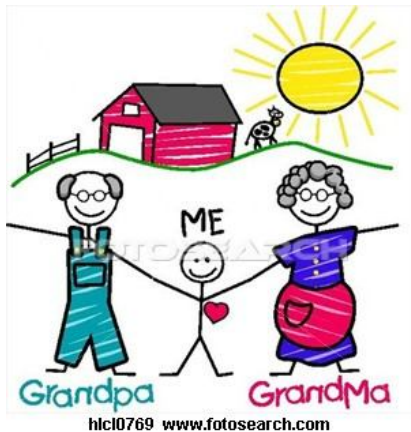
