Speaker: Victoria Ezagui, Master Gardner

Topic: Spring Planting – having a plan is crucial to a successful garden. Location, size, containment, soil prep, water needs, amount of sun needed are all big factors. Plant what you like to eat in the veggie and herb garden or native plants that are drought resistant in flower beds. Choose heirloom seeds, they are a little more expensive but more productive and more disease resistant. Start seeds in eggshells and label what they are. This can make transplanting into the beds so easy. Make a drawing of the garden and label what you have planted where. This will help you know what is coming up. Check your garden daily. Not all insects are harmful, many can be picked off or sprayed off with water. If you can, avoid harmful insecticides. Clean your garden tools often to avoid the spread of a disease from one plant to another.
