Topic: Children's Advocacy Center of Central Texas- **Our Mission Statement:** The mission of the Children's Advocacy Center of Central Texas is to provide comprehensive services that promote hope, healing, and justice for abused and neglected children. **Our Vision:** To restore the lives of abused children and ultimately end the cycle of abuse. **Our Core Values:** 1. Provide advocacy and specialized services to child abuse victims that restore lives and promote healing. 2. Ensure our services improve outcomes for child abuse victims and their families. 3. Approach child abuse cases from a collaborative perspective. 4. Promote community awareness of child abuse intervention services. 5. Collaborate and partner with community stakeholders to educate and promote child abuse prevention. This non profit organization was started in 1985 and came to Texas in 1997. They helped 187 kids in the first year and was partnered with CASA for 8 years. It is a one stop shop. The abused child will only have to tell their story one time and the Multi Disciplinary Team will take it from there to investigate and bring it through to justice system while meeting the needs of the child physically as well as mentally. In 2021 they assisted 872 kids and provided 2159 services. One area we wanted to support is their "Care Bag Room" which gives a care bag to help the child feel safe and loved. 92% of the abused children knew the offender.
