## HH Kiwanis Club Meeting 06-24-25

### **Speaker: Amy Brennan**

Topic: The <u>Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA)</u> in Texas is a program designed to reward, retain, and recruit effective teachers, particularly in high-needs schools. It provides funding to districts that implement local designation systems, allowing them to designate highly effective teachers as <u>Recognized</u>, <u>Exemplary</u>, or <u>Master</u>. These designations generate additional funding for the district, a portion of which is intended to go to the designated teacher. Designations issued through a local designation system are valid for five school years. Once the designation expires, the teacher may be issued a new designation if they continue to work in a district with an approved designation system and meet the district's performance criteria.

Teachers may only have one active designation at a time. Designated teachers working in a district with a local designation system may be put forth for a higher designation within the five-year window if they meet the district's performance criteria. In these cases, the higher designation replaces the lower designation, and the five-year clock restarts. Teachers may not be put forth by a district for a lower or equal designation. The funding available for the teacher incentive allotment varies by designation:

- Recognized teachers: \$3,000 to \$9,000 per teacher
- Exemplary teachers: \$6,000 to \$18,000 per teacher
- Master teachers: \$12,000 to \$32,000 per teacher
