**Topic: Cedar Trees: Ashe juniper:** Also known as mountain cedar, post cedar, Mexican cedar, blueberry cedar, or Texas cedar, this native evergreen is part of the *Juniperus* genus and has been in Texas since before humans. It prefers shallow, rocky, calcium-rich soil and grows well in the Edwards Plateau, also known as the Hill Country. Ashe juniper trees have reddish-brown bark that peels into strips, light brown wood, and female trees produce dark blue, berry-like cones with sweet flesh. The wood is often used for fence posts and fuel-wood, and the bark is used by golden-cheeked warblers to build nests. However, Ashe juniper trees can also be invasive and pollinate between December and March, which can cause cedar fever in some people. Symptoms of cedar fever include sneezing, sore throat, and burning eyes.

**Blueberry cedar:** *This species is more common in central and south-central Texas. (Female) The Male tree will have a brown cast to it. That is the pollen we are all allergic to.*


Flag Program: The flag room will be open at 7 am and 5 pm on July 4th
